Terms and Conditions

All pitches are offered under the following terms and conditions.

1. The charge is £100.00 per standard pitch
2. The fee to traders/ businesses is non-refundable unless for any reason the event is cancelled by the One Wirral officials.
3. Applications are only complete once payment has been received.
4. Pitches are not confirmed until the applicant has received notification from a One Wirral official.
5. All Food Vendors are responsible for supplying any equipment needed for their stall and must ensure that it is in good, safe working order.
6. Food Vendors are solely responsible for setting up their pitch and must only do so in the space they are allocated
7. Any gazebos or other equipment must be correctly erected and secured in case of adverse weather conditions. Please note Food Vendors will be situated on the road. Food Vendors must comply with all current health and safety regulations, particularly with respect to equipment and public safety.
8. All property, including equipment, stock and vehicles, is brought to the event at the Food Vendors' own risk.
9. All Food vendors are required to have their own Public/Products Liability Insurance in place to cover their involvement in the event. Food Vendors must supply proof of this if requested.
10. No flammable goods or equipment are to be used at any time, except for appropriate use on permitted food vendor pitches (Suitable certification and insurance cover applies – copies of documentation must be supplied when requested).
11. No food and/or drink of any description is to be sold for consumption on site without prior consent of the organiser. Food Vendors selling food and/or drink must comply with current food safety legislation and produce relevant licences and certificates as requested.
12. Mains electricity will not be available. It is the responsibility of the Food Vendor to ensure that his/her equipment/generator is suitable, compatible and complies with all Health and Safety requirements.
13. Food type must be declared on the booking form and any changes authorised by the One Wirral Team before the event date It will make sure only there is only one stall offering that food type. Businesses are not permitted to hold individual raffles on the day.
14. No live animals or fish are to be sold or offered as prizes by any stall holder.
15. All stall holders must abide by the set up/ close down procedure issued by the One Wirral officials, including adhering to the one-way traffic system in operation in the park that day and specified times when vehicles are not permitted on the grounds.
16. The event has a zero tolerance policy on alcohol. No alcohol will be permitted within the festival area.
17. All stalls/pitches are to be manned by a responsible adult at all times.
18. All refuse must be stored safely until the end of the festival and disposed of in a responsible way by all pitch holders. The pitch must be left clear at the end of the day. Failure to do so will incur a £50 fine.
19. All owners, exhibitors, their agents and employees, whether formally employed or not and including any volunteers, shall be subject to the rules and regulations set out by the One Wirral officials and appointed stewards. The One Wirral officials have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, stall holders must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the One Wirral officials and stewards.

Nothing in these conditions is to be taken as relieving or excusing the stall holder, their agents or employees, from any legal duty or responsibility.
