

Wirral's Unique Diversity and Inclusion Festival!

Terms and Conditions

All pitches are offered under the following terms and conditions.

- 1. The charge is £35.00 per standard pitch (5M X 5M). This is refundable to non-profit organisations providing they attend on the day. This payment will be retained in the event of a 'no show' or late cancellation (less than 2 weeks before the event).
- 2. Applications are only complete once payment or the refundable deposit has been received.
- 3. Pitches are not confirmed until the applicant has received notification from a One Wirral official.
- 4. All stall holders must bring their own tables, chairs, gazebo and any other equipment needed. All stall holders are responsible for ensuring everything is in good, safe working order.
- 5. Stall holders are solely responsible for setting up their pitch and must only do so in the space they are allocated.
- 6. Any gazebos or other equipment must be correctly erected and secured in case of adverse weather conditions. Please note stalls will be situated on the road leading to the Park Grand Entrance. This is a gravel surface and too hard for tent pegs. Gazebos will need to be weighted down instead. Stall holders must comply with all current health and safety regulations, particularly with respect to equipment and public safety.
- 7. All property, including equipment, stock and vehicles, is brought to the event at the stall holder's own risk.
- 8. All stall holders are required to have their own Public Liability Insurance in place to cover their involvement in the event (to include cover for any workshops/ showcases that are delivered). Stall holders must supply proof of this if requested.
- 9. No flammable goods or equipment are to be used at any time, except for appropriate use on permitted food vendor pitches (Suitable certification and insurance cover applies copies of documentation must be supplied at time of booking).
- 10. No food and drink of any description are to be sold for consumption on site without prior consent of the organiser.
- 11. Mains electricity will not be available to stall holders. It is the responsibility of the stall holder to ensure that his/her equipment/generator is suitable, compatible and complies with all Health and Safety requirements. NO PETROL GENERATORS ARE ALLOWED.
- 12. Fundraising on charity stalls is permitted but general collecting away from stalls is not. Collection buckets will not be permitted other than those associated with the 2 lead partners. In addition, organisations are not permitted to hold individual raffles on the day.
- 13. Intended 'activity/ offer' must be declared on the booking form and any changes authorised by the One Wirral Team before the event date.
- 14. No live animals or fish are to be sold or offered as prizes by any stall holder.
- 15. All stall holders must abide by the set up/ close down procedure issued by the One Wirral officials, including adhering to the one-way traffic system in operation in the park on the day and specified times when vehicles are not permitted on the grounds.
- 16. The event has a zero tolerance policy on alcohol. No alcohol will be permitted within the festival area.
- 17. All stalls/pitches are to be manned by a responsible adult at all times.
- 18. All refuse must be stored safely until the end of the festival and disposed of in a responsible way by all pitch holders. The pitch must be left clear at the end of the day. Failure to do so will incur a £50 fine.
- 19. All owners, exhibitors, their agents and employees, whether formally employed or not and including any volunteers, shall be subject to the rules and regulations set out by the One Wirral officials and appointed stewards. The One Wirral officials have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, stall holders must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the One Wirral officials and stewards.

Nothing in these conditions is to be taken as relieving or excusing the stall holder, their agents or employees, from any legal duty or responsibility.
